"Don't Sing It If You Don't Mean It!"

SFBAC NATS Musical Theatre Workshop with Meredith Pyle

On January 29th, SFBAC NATS held a musical theatre workshop presented by Meredith Pyle at Montclair Presbyterian Church in Oakland with 31 teachers, students, and family members in attendance. Voice teachers and students learned about Florence Birdwell's methodology, "Don't sing it, if You don't mean it!"—namely, how to encourage singers to communicate and connect with the audience using more than just the singing voice. Pyle presented actionable tools, such as monologuing the lyrics, or building a sound symphony, or using the Junto wheel of emotions and feelings, so that voice teachers and students got first-hand experience in cultivating positivity, vulnerability, mindfulness, and an atmosphere of play in the voice studio. The presentation was followed by a voice class in which four singers, Sami Kuncharapu,

D'Vine Riley, Cecily Feliz, and Sravya Vakkalanka, performed selections from musical theatre repertoire with pianist, Chun Mei Wilson. Meredith Pyle worked with each singer on different aspects of her methodology using tools such as personal anecdotes, monologuing, silly dilly gestures, and Opera Works cards created by Anne Baltz to cultivate bravery and vulnerability in performance. Needless to say, this was an insightful, informative, and dynamic workshop. Thank you, Meredith Pyle!
