SFBAC National Association of Teachers of Singing Recital Guidelines

- 1. Female performers should wear knee-length (or longer) skirts, dresses, or dressy slacks with blouses.
- 2. Male performers should wear dress slacks and dress shirt. Ties and jackets are optional.
- 3. Dress shoes are required for all performers. Please, no athletic shoes, flip-flops, etc..
- 4. There will be a rehearsal lasting approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes before the recital. Arrive warmed-up. If you wish additional time, you should schedule a separate rehearsal (at your own expense) with the accompanist in advance.
- 5. All recitals will start on time.
- 6. All music must be memorized.
- 7. Please be aware of recital etiquette, i.e. bowing after your performance, acknowledging the accompanist, sitting quietly during a performance, staying for the entire program, etc.
- 8. Singers need not announce the name of their teacher before singing, as it is already included in the program.
 - You may give a brief spoken introduction to your songs, but it is not required.
- 9. No water bottles are allowed on stage.
- 10. Flash photography is not permitted during a recital. Video cameras may be used, provided they are set up in the rear of the recital hall and kept clear of the aisles.
- 11. Turn off all cell-phones, pagers, and laptops during a performance.
